


ABOUT CROSTON OLD SCHOOL

Croston Old school is a multi-purpose community resource centre which opened in April 2001 after extensive refurbishment.

It is a Grade II listed building which originates from 1660 and was rebuilt in 1827. It is in the centre of the village at the end of Church Street within an Article 4 conservation area, next to the 900 year old church and alongside the River Yarrow.

Until 1999 the buildings were used by Lancashire County Council as a school for up to 60 children. In March 1999 the children were re-located to new school buildings and the Old School was left vacant.

Following extensive consultation a registered charity was established to raise funds to develop the building. Outline planning permission was granted in the spring of 2000. A grant from the National Lottery Charities board for £481,062 funded the majority of a £520,000 scheme to convert the building.

Over £20,000 was raised by other grants and local fundraising.

In the North wing we have a large community space for meetings and celebrations in the Old School hall and smaller conference rooms for meetings etc upstairs.

There is also a licensed bar facility on this side of the building.

In the South wing we have a further community space which can also be used for meetings or celebrations too.

The venue has gone from strength to strength and is much in demand for wedding receptions and christening parties as well as providing a home to many local voluntary groups. We also hold regular concerts through our partnership with Spot-On Lancashire.

The board of Trustees employs a Centre manager, Caretaker, Bar/Events Manager & events assistants to oversee the day to day running of the centre together with our volunteers.



HISTORY

The school was erected in 1660 by the Reverend James Hyatt at his own cost, and was intended to be a "free school for the good education of the children of the parish".

It was rebuilt by public subscription in 1827 and was home to the village infant school until March 1999.

This Grade II listed building is now an excellent community facility

AFTER THE CEREMONY

We are not licensed for ceremonies, however we are lucky to have some lovely registry offices, churches and ceremony venues just a short drive away.

CHURCH CEREMONY

If a church ceremony is your dream, the Wedding Team will await your arrival from your chosen venue, with your choice of drink, be it a chilled glass of fizz or a bottle of beer to celebrate you as newlyweds.

CIVIL CEREMONY

Often our couples choose a ceremony at a local registry office, town hall or venue close to their hearts. Some of our previous happy couples have arrived from Chorley, Preston, Southport, Ormskirk and Clitheroe registry offices or even the stunning Astley Hall in Chorley.

Once we know your ceremony time we can advise further on the rest of your celebration timings.

Alternative welcome drinks options such as Pimm's or selected bottled beers are available on request, or perhaps upgrade to Champagne, supplements may apply.

The drinks package you offer your guests is entirely up to you.

We have a reasonably priced, fully stocked licensed bar, and it can be a pay bar throughout the day & evening. Alternatively, you can decide to pay for all your guests' drinks or have a bar tab for an allocated time. We serve a variety of real ales, ciders and lagers alongside a wide selection of wines and spirits and of course soft drinks.

More often we will put together a 'drinks package' of reception drinks on arrival, wine on the table, a toast.

We can also offer a tea and coffee station after your meal.

The licensed bar can be available from noon until 10.30pm.

We have 2 drinks package options available, but of course these can be tailored to your individual requirements..











WEDDING timeline example

13:00 TO 17:00 - DAY BEFORE

You are welcome to drop off everything and set up the Hall with the help of your family, friends and chosen suppliers. (Please note any tables and chairs must be delivered between 10:30–12:00)

12:00 SERVICE, ON THE BIG DAY

13:00 TO 13:30 - ARRIVAL AT CROSTON OLD SCHOOL

13:00 TO 14:30 - DRINKS RECEPTION

Your arrival drinks will be served, guests will socialise and photos will be taken.

14:30 - GUESTS SEATED & COUPLE ANNOUNCED INTO THE ROOM.

14:30 TO 16:30 - WEDDING BREAKFAST SERVED BY CHOOSEN CATERER

16:30 TO 17:00 - SPEECHES & TOASTS

17:00 TO 18:00 - GUESTS ASKED TO VACATE THE ROOM

Wedding TWILIGHT PACKAGE

Our Twilight Wedding Package is perfect for couples who wish to have a slightly less extravagant wedding day or are on a stricter budget. Arriving from 6pm onwards. This would be perfect for those having later ceremonies and wishing to arrive straight into an evening party. The timing here is such that sit down meals, formal speeches, table layouts etc are not required and thus any headache these could potentially bring to your special day is forgotten.



What's Included

Why not hire Croston Old School for light refreshments whilst your photographs are being taken?


Refreshments can be served in the hall, foyer, South Wing or outside in our Riverside Courtyard areas.

THINGS TO CONSIDER

Planning a wedding involves a multitude of details, and selecting the perfect venue is one of the most crucial decisions. A well-thought-out wedding venue checklist can ensure you cover all bases.

- Start by determining your budget, as this will narrow down your options significantly.
- Next, consider the venue's location and vicinity to your ceremony location.
- · Assess the venue's capacity to ensure it accommodates your guest list comfortably.
- Enquire about the availability of the your chosen caterers and suppliers, check that the vendors you are desiring are permitted.
- Check the venue's availability for your desired date and understand any of the venue's limitations.
- Understand what's included in the hire fee and what you will may wish to order in such as round tables, chairs, and alternative linens.
- Review the venue's cancellation policy and payment terms to avoid any surprises.
- Finally, visit the site in person to get a feel for the ambiance and ensure it aligns with your vision for the big day.



To make the process smoother, here's also a basic wedding to-do list to get you started:

- 1. Set a Budget: Determine how much you're willing to spend and allocate funds to different aspects of the wedding.
- 2. Choose a Date and Venue: Decide on a wedding date and book the venue for the ceremony and reception.
- 3. Take out Wedding Insurance and make sure you are covered for every eventuality
- 4. Create a Guest List: Compile a list of all the people you would like to invite.
- 5. Hire Suppliers: Research and book essential vendors, including a photographer, videographer, caterer, florist, and DJ.
- 6. Select Attire: Choose the wedding dress, groom's attire, and outfits for the bridal party.
- 7. Send Invitations: Design and send out wedding invitations and save-the-date cards.
- $8. \ Plan \ the \ Ceremony \ and \ Reception: Organise \ the \ order \ of \ events, finalise \ the \ menu \ and \ seating \ arrangements.$
- 9. Arrange Transportation and Accommodation: Book transportation for the wedding day and reserve any accommodation required.
- 10. Liaise with your ceremony venue, what information do they need from you? Have you confirmed the timings?
- 11. Finalise Details: Confirm all arrangements with the venue who will create a wedding day timeline make sure they are fully aware of all elements of the day.
- 12. Check all the details and timings with your suppliers.

DON'T FORGET if you are going away after the wedding to pack and make any necessary travel arrangements, so you can simply enjoy your day!

Remember, flexibility is key, so adjust the list according to your specific needs and timeline.



FREQUENTLY ASKED Questions

CAN THE CLOSING TIME BE EXTENDED? HOW BIG ARE THE TABLES YOU HAVE?

Sadly as we have a convenant on the building the bar and any music must close/finish by 10.30pm with the building secured by 11pm. Many DJ's have commented that this leaves guests on a real high and is the perfect time to end as most of your guests are still there and everyone can enjoy the end together. Why not start the day earlier? Or have an afterparty at The Wheatsheaf, Croston.

WHAT IS THE EARLIEST TIME I CAN HAVE MY WEDDING RECEPTION FROM?

We are licensed from 12 Noon and therefore with services taking place locally we would recommend planning to arrive no earlier than 12pm.

WHAT DO CROSTON OLD SCHOOL NEED FROM ME?

- Provide venue with a list of suppliers including their contact details
- Public Liability Insurance, PAT Testing and Risk Assessment documents from suppliers
- Provide venue with final guests numbers no later than
 1 month before
- Table layout plan with amount of guests on each table for our team to put out the furniture.
- Provide caterer with a table plan detailing all catering requirements

HOW MANY GUESTS CAN I HAVE?

For a sit down meal the maximum capacity to allow for tables and seating is 80.

DO YOU OFFER CORKAGE?

As licensed premises we do not offer corkage. Only alcohol purchased within the venue can be consumed here. If there is something in particular you would like us to stock, please ask and we will certainly see what we can arrange.

Our rectangular tables are 5ft \times 2.5ft, we have 16 available for the hall and 10 in the South Wing and 90 chairs.

CAN I HIRE IN TABLES & CHAIRS?

Yes these can be ordered from SJ Enterprises on O1772 267222, please arrange for these to be dropped off the day before your wedding between 10.30am-12pm and collected the day after the wedding by 11am.

WHEN DO I NEED TO BOOK THE SOUTH WING ADDITIONAL SPACE?

This area can be booked up to 1 month prior to the wedding.

CAN LUSE ANY CATERER?

We would very much prefer weddings to use the caterers we have worked with previously as they know the set up and work well with us. If you do wish to use a caterer that hasn't worked here before, we would kindly ask that before booking they come along and have a look around the venue to make sure they understand the space and limitations

CAN YOU OFFER FOOD SERVICE?

Our team do not provide any sort of waiting on services and will not be involved with food service. This must be arranged with your catering team.

CAN I HAVE FOOD VANS?

It may be possible to liaise with the church to have a horse box style food truck positioned in the church car park for evening food. Again we would kindly ask that companies do measure and make sure they can fit their vehicle through the church gates prior to you booking in with them. It does generally work better for evening food caterers to work from a gazebo in the courtyard area as much as possible (please note direct vehicle access is not available here).







TABLE LAYOUT

Options

Your guest numbers will effect the table layout options available.

You are very welcome to use our rectangular tables and standard banqueting chairs.

Your choice of top table be it long, round one or banqueting style tables can change the room layout. If ordering tables please talk to us about the layout prior to placing an order. Please see the table layout suggestions on the following page.










